### Sierra Cedars Community Services District Water Conservation Plan

Under Ordinance No 22 - 1 (adopted by the District in September 2022): Every homeowner in the District is required to shut off water supply to his or her property if the cabin will be unoccupied for 24 hours. All cabins must have a turn off valve. This rule applies at all times and during any of the stages described in this program.

### Stage 1 (Green) Water Conservation

- 1. No free-flowing hoses
- 2. Spas, fountains must have recirculation pump
- 3. Runoff to other properties from watering prohibited
- 4. Repair leaks immediately
- 5. No washing driveway/sidewalks (except for sanitary purposes)
- 6. No conveying water to another property
- 7. Conserve water (refer to District CC&R's)

### Stage 2 (Blue) MODERATE

- 1- 7: Same as Stage 1 Water Conservation
- 8. No outside watering on weekends/holidays

#### Fees:

- 1. \$200 fee for each non-routine meter reading.
- 2. \$0.002+ fee per gallon of water lost. Covers the cost of electricity.
- 3. All time and material expenses in excess of those in #1 and #2.
- 4. Water reconnection fee is \$100

## Stage 3 (Orange) CRITICAL

- 1-7: Same as Stage 1 plus no district water used to fill spas, fountains
- 8. Outside watering prohibited
- 9. Indoor water conservation measures

# Fines: Per 12 Month Period...

1<sup>st</sup> offense \$125 \*
2<sup>nd</sup> offense \$300 \*
3<sup>rd</sup> offense \$600 plus water shut off

\*plus possible water shut off

### Stage 4 (Red) SEVERE

- 1-9: Same as Stage 3
- 10. No district water used for construction
- 11. No new water connections
- 12. Water Conservation measures enacted as needed
- 13. Water to rental properties may be curtailed
- 14. Fines and fees imposed for excessive water usage
- 15. Water Flow Restrictors installed for continuous abusers
